

Equality and diversity: carrying out equality impact assessments

The Learning and Skills Improvement Service (LSIS) has designed a series of seminars to explore how to effectively carry out equality impact assessments (EIAs). These are timely, given that the new inspection framework places greater emphasis on equal opportunities, and EIAs are a key tool to help embed and improve equality and diversity throughout the organisation.

Overview

These are practical hands-on seminars.

The morning will take you through each step of the equality impact assessment process and give you the opportunity to put into practice what you learn.

The afternoon will look at strategic approaches to help your organisation embed the process in everyday practice so EIAs are the responsibility of everyone, not just one person.

The seminar will consider the pitfalls to avoid when conducting EIAs, as well as explore good practice in the sector.
